- **Entries:** Entries will be done online at www.baumspage.com. The window is already open, and it will close *at 11:00 AM on Wednesday, May 15.* There will be no scratch window. Enter no more than 2 individuals per event. Please remember to enter the *most consistent times*, not the very best one! We will accept changes up to the beginning of the meet on Friday, but if possible email them to the address above. Lane assignments, starting heights, etc., will be posted on baumspage and emailed to each head coach sometime Wednesday afternoon or evening.
- *Workers:* Each school will supply one person to act as a backup timer, plus a worker to help with a field event. Field event assignments are on the schedule page. **Please email these workers to Matt Harp at his email address below.**
- *<u>Timing:</u>* We will be using our FinishLynx fully automatic timing system. All your times will be measured to the hundredth of a second.</u>
- *Facilities:* We have an 8-lane all-weather track. Please use ¹/₈ or ¹/₄ inch spikes. Tape is acceptable for marking the jumps, and tennis balls or the like should be used for relays. Please use your own batons. Please put camps outside the track, and try to stay off the football field.
- *Implements:* Please weigh in your implements in the garage by the pole vault pit upon arrival.
- *Sprints*: In the 100/110 M Hurdles, 100 M Dash, and 200 M Dash, the heats will be seeded as evenly as possible based on submitted times, while keeping athletes from the same school in different heats. In the 300 M Hurdles and 400 M Dash, athletes will be placed into two heats, run from slower to faster, based on submitted times. However, anyone can score from either heat.
- *<u>Stuff</u>*: We will have our concession stand open, with t-shirts available. Admission is \$4.00 adults, and \$3.00 students.
- <u>Schedule</u>: Please review the attached time schedule for other details.
- <u>Awards:</u> There will be a team trophy for champion. Individually, we will score 6 places. The top 3 placers will receive All-TAAC medals. There will also be an Athlete of the Year Plaque and a Coach of the Year Plaque awarded. Awards will be available in the press box after the meet.
- **Coaches:** There will be a short coaches' meeting at 4:15 in the garage near the pole vault pit. There will also be a hospitality room with snacks and drinks for all the coaches in the garage as well.
