Schedule: 5:00 - Open girls – athletes that will not run in the varsity girls' race
5:40 – Open boys – athletes that will not run in the varsity boys' race
6:20 – Varsity girls – must have at least 5 and a max. of 7 athletes to run in this race
6:50 – Varsity boys – must have at least 5 and a max. of 7 athletes to run in this race

Awards: Individual awards - regardless of school division
Varsity Race: medals for the first 15 finishers, ribbons for finishers 16-30
Open Race: ribbons for finishers 1-20
Most Valuable Runner – Plaque presented to the top overall runner based on time ran in either race (not voted on, strictly based on time ran)

Team awards (We will have two divisions based on school enrollment submitted to OHSAA)
1st place boys / 1st place girls – Big schools & Small schools
2nd place boys / 2nd place girls – Big schools & Small schools

Course: Accurate 3200-meter course at Eastwood High School
Flat, a few turns, grass and woods, excellent spectator course
NEW this YEAR: the course has changed and athletes will finish on the track – ¼ inch spikes ONLY

General Information:

- Course will be open for inspection with maps. Feel free to preview the course at an earlier date. Please contact one of the people listed below.
- Concessions and restrooms will be available at the football stadium.
- A limited supply of “Flying Eagle” T-shirts will be on sale. Cost will be \$15
- Team camps will be up by the football stadium along the fence away from the parking lot.
- **Buses should enter on the west side of Eastwood High School, off Luckey Road. Athletes will be dropped off and then busses will be instructed to park between the high school and middle school.**
- Coaches – please remind parents to stay back from the chute until race officials have excused their athlete.
- Team entry is \$150.00 per school, \$75.00 per team, or \$10 per athlete. Please return this with your entry if you haven't yet paid.
- **You may enter a maximum of 7 athletes, but must have at least 5 athletes in the varsity race. There are an unlimited number of entries for the open race.**
- **CHIP RETURN BIN – After the race please return all chips to the chip return bin which will be located under the goal post on the side of the football field by the finish line. There will be a \$5.00 fee for all chips that don't get returned.**

- Entries must be submitted at www.baumspage.com by **9:00 PM Monday, August 26, 2024**. Most accounts were kept from last year, but still check your account early to see if it is still valid. If not, you will have to apply and create a new baumspage account.
