

Pickerington North High School 2024 OHSAA Cross Country Regional Tournament Saturday, October 26th, 2024

<u>Course</u>: The course is mostly grass with two pavement crossings. The terrain ranges from flat to gradual upgrades with one short, but steep hill. Approximately 1,200 meters of the course is wood chipped trail through a wooded area. 1/4 to 3/8 inch spikes are recommended. Course inspections can be done during the week leading up to the race but must happen after 3:15pm.

<u>Eligibility and Rules:</u> Refer to OHSAA website at http://www.ohsaa.org. The team coach or faculty representative must accompany your school's qualifiers. All OHSAA rules and regulations apply to dress, participation, and conduct.

Recreational Equipment, Pets and Site Regulations: Recreational equipment such as Frisbees, footballs, etc. will not be permitted at the meet site. No smoking is permitted on school property. PETS ARE NOT PERMITTED AT REGIONAL SITES!

Pass Gate:

Individual Qualifiers: each qualifying competitor = one coach

Team Qualifiers: 11 Total (7 team members, 2 alternates, 2 coaches)

Note: Passes issued per this section are per TEAM, not per SCHOOL. A school will receive four coaches' passes if it advances both genders' teams.

<u>Available Facilities:</u> Concessions stands serving drinks, food trucks, and indoor restrooms are on site. Locker room facilities are not available. Come dressed to participate.

Awards: Awards will be presented in the stadium 30 minutes after the conclusion of each race.

<u>Parking:</u> All participants and spectators should enter Pickerington North High School facilities from Refugee Road at the traffic light across from Kroger. Parking has changed for this year due to construction. Please have your driver drop your team off at the "Team Entrance" by the big white tent for packet pick up. Buses will then park either at Lakeview Jr. High School, Kroger (across the street from North), or Sycamore Creek Church (8100 Refugee Rd.). Make sure to get your driver's phone number for team pick up. We are trying to keep the back parking lot free from spectator parking and team vans. Spectators will park in the south lot of North or Lakeview.
