

## Coaches Information 2024

1. U.S.G.A. rules shall be used. **Ball will be played down – depends on course conditions.** Check rule course sheet.
2. Faculty representative/coach must be with each team. Two coaches are allowed to speak with players. Both must be School Board certified.
3. **Please put first and last name of your player on the score card (in ink and legibly please). Check iWanamaker App for more information on scoring. This new App is mandatory. Tournament officials will not help with this. You must seed your players (1-5) on Wanamaker. Seed other players as well.**
4. Players report nine hole scores at the turn at the scoring tables and the final nine holes at the scoring tables. Final scores will then be posted on the score board. **Only PLAYERS reporting scores will be allowed at the scoring tables( NO spectators or coaches or other non scoring players). In Sectional Only is a 12 Stroke limit per hole.**
5. Each player is responsible for the correctness of the score recorded for each hole. Players will rotate cards at the start of the match. **Check ALL scores after each hole so there are no problems later.** Also put scores in the live scoring app as well. **Do not** sign card until official scorer tells player to do so. (Please sign card legibly). Official scorers will add final scores. **Paper scorecard is the official results.**
6. Coaches please inform players:  
**Players report 15 minutes before Tee Time.**  
Identify and mark golf balls.  
If playing a provisional ball, announce and ball type  
Play two balls if not sure of ruling and keep two scores.  
No talking with spectators and/or parents.  
14 club rule No Headphones.  
Sportsmanship is a must!! No throwing of clubs, profanity etc.
7. Coaching rule:
  - a. Coach(es) are allowed to speak with players during the round.
  - b. If player is in bunker – player must leave bunker to speak with the coach. The coach may enter the bunker after the player leaves to rake. May speak with the player if player is on green.
  - c. Coaches are NOT permitted to make a ruling on any team including their own. A coach from an opposing team may NOT give advice to a player on another team without that coach being punished for a violation of coaching rules.
8. **No caddying allowed or anyone pushing a cart for the player or riding in a cart unless permission by Tournament Manager. Spectators are NOT permitted to converse with players.**
9. **The head coach and/or assistant coach or school designate must wear identifying name tag on the course.**
10. (D1, D-2 and D-3 Sectional at Jaycees) Flags: RED – up front; YELLOW – middle; BLUE – back
11. (D1 Sectional and D-2 District at Crown Hill ) – on flagstick –high – back, middle – middle, low- front.)
12. **White Tees** (D 1 at Crown Hill, D2 and D3 Sectional at Jaycees and D2 District at Crown Hill ). D1 Girls sectional at Jaycees will use **Red Tees. Red /Gold Tees** for ladies at Crown Hill D2 Girls District – Drop Areas are on rule sheet. Please read and/or discuss course rule sheet to players.
13. Yardage Markers in fairway – Blue 200 – White 150 – Red 100 to center of green.
14. Rules committee: Randy Williams Tournament Manager, and other rules officials to be named later.
15. Marshals will be on the course. (They are NOT rule officials.)
16. **BOYS-** Five teams and five individuals (not on qualifying team) D-2 and D-3 Five Teams and Five Individuals (not on qualifying teams) to District Tournament. D2 at Crown Hill on October 2 and D3 at Portsmouth Elks on September 30.  
**GIRLS D-1 Top Five (5) teams and top Five (5) individuals move to District at Eaglesticks on October 8.**  
**Girls D 2 District at Crown Hill – 4 teams and 4 individuals each from 3 sectionals on Tuesday, October 1, 2024**  
D1 Boys 4 teams..4 and..to district.
17. D-2 Boys District Tournament - .Two Teams and Two Individuals to State Tournament.
18. D-2 Girls District – Two Team and Two Individual to State Tournament
19. Any ties will start on Hole 1.
