## **Information**

Tournament Information for D1 Sectionals

- 1. THERE WILL BE NO CARTS FOR THE SPECTATORS. If the course allows coach's carts on the course, each school will get the use of 1 cart.
- 2. COACHES AND PLAYERS-Players are responsible for live scoring using the OHSAA Golf App during the round. In the event a competitor does not have a mobile device, an alternate person such as a fellow competitor, coach, or authorized representative may enter the scores in a timely manner as possible.
- 3. A PRINTED SCORECARD WILL BE GIVEN TO THE PLAYER AND IT WILL BE THE OFFICIAL SCORECARD FOR THE ROUND.
- 4. PRACTICE RANGE-after checking in, proceed to the pro shop where you will receive a token for each player. Please hit off the mats and do not use the driver. Because of the large number of the teams teeing off in each wave, each team is to use two mats to hit the range balls.
- 5. The following teams will use the range from 8:15 to 9:00. Mats 1&2-Dublin Jerome; Mats 3 & 4-Upper Arlington; Mats 5 & 6-Big Walnut; Mats 7 & 8-Olentangy Berlin; Mats 9 & 10-Olentangy; Mats 11 & 12-Westerville Central; Mats 13 & 14-Newark; and Mats 15 & 16-Lancaster.
- 6. These teams will use the range from 9:00 to 9:45. Mats 1& 2-Bexley; Mats 3 & 4-Delaware Hayes; Mats 5 & 6-Teays Valley; Mats 7 & 8-Groveport-Madison; Mats 9 & 10-Licking Valley; Mats 11 & 12-Canal Winchester; Mats 13 & 14-Licking Heights; and Mats 15 & 16-Centennial.
- 7. BUNKERS-If a player's ball is in the bunker and is in water, find a dry spot in the same bunker as close to the same distance from the pin as possible. Place your ball in the bunker. If a player chooses to take the ball out of the bunker, he incurs a 1 stroke penalty. He must keep the ball on the same line as the pin and spot where the ball was. If a bunker is completely full of water, it will be marked as ground under repair.
