

Attention: Athletic Director/Boy's Golf Coach:

September 2024

The Boys Eastern District Division II Sectional Golf Tournament at Cadiz Country Club will be played on **Monday**, **September 23**, **2024 starting at 9:00 AM**. Rain date: Wednesday, September 25th.

Due to the extreme drought conditions and water shortages, Cadiz Country Club will look different to those that have played in the past. Greens and tees are being watered daily and will be in good shape. The rest of the golf course will be hard and fast for tournament play. Additional rule modifications will be in place to ensure the fairest playing conditions possible.

- The OHSAA is utilizing the <u>OHSAA Golf</u> app powered by <u>iWanamaker</u> to provide live scoring for the sectional, district, and state tournaments, but will continue to use the **Baumspage** to provide the traditional support for all sectional and district golf tournaments this fall.
- 2. For 2024, rosters will need to be submitted on the OHSAA Golf app.
- 3. Results will be posted live on the OHSAA Golf app or www.iwanamaker.com

For the **OHSAA** Golf app:

- 1. If you haven't already done so, all coaches and players will need to install OHSAA Golf app on their mobile devices and create an account on iWanamaker.
 - a. If you haven't used the OHSAA Golf app, click the Getting Started link.
 - b. See **OHSAA Golf App powered by iWanamaker** on the second page for additional information.
 - c. After creating your account, click **Help** to select the **Roster Management** link and view the YouTube video.
 - d. If you haven't used the OHSAA Golf app, you can set up a practice meet and have golfers enter scores.
- 2. Log in to your iWanamaker account | click Roster | edit the Seed numbers for your athletes.
 - a. Click Online Entry-Screenshots to view a two-page guide with screenshots.
 - b. Submit your roster in seed order before 12:00 noon one week prior to the start of the tournament!
 - c. Select {your tournament} | click Edit Event | select {your team} | click the three dots ··· | Add Golfers | Select Athletes | Import | Make sure they are in seed order from 1 to 5!

For Baumspage:

- 1. Nothing will be submitted on Baumspage
- 2. Rosters will be imported from iWanamaker
- 3. Pairings, tee times, and tournament results will be posted on baumspage and the OHSAA Golf app.

OHSAA Golf App powered by iWanamaker

Registering as a golf coach, AD, golfer or spectator is done with the <u>OHSAA Golf</u> app from the app store. ADs, Coaches and Golfers are added automatically to their respective schools when they get the <u>OHSAA Golf</u> app powered by <u>iWanamaker</u> from the app store. Please install the app and during the registration process you will be added to your school with the correct role.

After you register using the OHSAA Golf app you will go to https://www.iwanamaker.com to manage your schedule and roster. To navigate to your school you can click on LEAGUES then Ohio High Athletic Association and find your school.

Spectators: Please advise parents

- All spectators must pre-purchase an online admission ticket at <u>www.ohsaa.org/tickets</u>.
 \$8.00 Adults
 \$5.00 Students
- 2. Results will be posted live on the **OHSAA Golf** app by iWanamaker
 - a) Parents wishing to follow the live scoring will need to install the OHSAA Golf App on their smartphone or the iWanamaker app on their computer.
 - b) To view they will need to purchase a ticket or pass.
 - c) Click the link OHSAA Golf App Event and Season Pass Information for details and pricing.
- 3. Spectators on the course must remain ½ hole ahead or behind the tee group they are following.
- 4. The Cadiz Country Club has a policy that no food be brought in by spectators.
 - a) You may bring-in coolers with water and soft drinks.
 - b) The clubhouse will be open with a typical menu and specials.

Greens Fee: Participating schools will not be charged green fees for competition rounds of play.

Practice Rounds: Call the Pro Shop (740-942-3610) to schedule a practice round.

- a. Practice round green fees for walkers will be \$15 per player.
- b. Please make sure your players dress appropriately
- c. Practice rounds may be scheduled in advance at non-peak hours.
- d. There are several tournaments and events during the week, so please check in advance.

Rules:

- A. The Rules of Golf, as approved by the United States Golf Association and R & A, for Stroke Play and OHSAA tournament regulations shall prevail for all tournaments sponsored by the OHSAA.
- B. The Rules of Golf include an optional Local Rule that allows players to drop a ball with 2 penalty strokes in an area near where the ball was lost or estimated to go out of bounds. The Local Rule is not one of the 24 Rules of Golf; it is an optional Local Rule. This 2-stroke optional Local Rule may NOT be used at the OHSAA Sectional, District, or State tournaments.
- C. OHSAA Local Rule Sectional Tournaments Only Maximum allowable score of 12 strokes shall be used during OHSAA tournament play at the sectional level. Should a player reach 12 strokes on a hole, the player shall stop play on that hole and record their score as a 12. A player's score who has used the 12-stroke limit may still contribute their score to a team / individual score.

Coaches: Please review with the members of your team the information found in the <u>2023 OHSAA Golf Regulations</u> and the <u>2024 OHSAA Tournament Golf Regulations</u> along with any other communications on Golf from the OHSAA.
