

Boys Division II Sectional Tournament

Rules

- USGA and OHSAA rules will govern all play.
- Players will play the **white** tees, Greens and Pines Courses.
- Because of the way the iWanamaker scoring app is set up, the Greens Course will be holes 1-9 and the Pines Course will be holes 10-18. The paper score cards will be set up this way as well.
- Out of bounds, defined by white stakes, on holes 9, 10, 11, 12, and 18
- Red penalty areas, defined by red lines, on holes 1 and 9 and the river behind 12 green.
- The high grass or unmowed areas are played as red penalty areas, defined by red lines.
- The water on #7 and #18 is a yellow penalty area, defined a yellow line.
- OHSAA Local Rule – A maximum allowable score of 12 strokes shall be used during the sectional tournament. If a player reaches 12 strokes on a hole, the player will stop play on that hole and record their score as a 12.
- Local rule for ball deflected by power line: If a player's ball strikes a power line, guy wire, or pole, the player must replay the stroke from a spot nearest to where the original ball was played.
- If in doubt of a rule, play two balls, record both scores, and inform the rules committee when your round is complete.
- Slow play will not be tolerated and will be monitored.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. A warning will be given on the first offense, two stroke penalty for a second offense, and disqualification on the third offense.
- Suspension of play: in case of inclement weather, suspension of play will be signaled by three short siren blasts. Players must discontinue play, mark their position on the course, and take shelter. Resumption of play will be signaled by one prolonged siren blast.
- Scoring: after play is completed, players will proceed to the pro shop patio. Results will be posted on baumspage.com and iWanamaker.
