Coaches Information U.S.G.A. rules shall be used. Ball will be played down – depending on course conditions. Check the rule course sheet.

Faculty representative/coach must be with each team. Two coaches are allowed to speak with players. Both must be School Board certified.

Please put the first and last name of your player on the scorecard (in ink and legibly please). Check iWanamaker App for more information on scoring. This new App is mandatory. Tournament officials will not help with this. You must seed your players (1-5) on both sites.

Players report nine hole scores at the turn at the scoring tables and the final nine holes at the scoring tables. Final scores will then be posted on the scoreboard. Only PLAYERS reporting scores will be allowed at the scoring tables (NO spectators or coaches or other non scoring players). In Sectional Only is a 12 Stroke limit per hole.

Each player is responsible for the correctness of the score recorded for each hole. Players will rotate cards at the start of the match. Check ALL scores after each hole so there are no problems later. Do not sign card until the official scorer tells the player to do so. (Please sign the card legibly). Official scorers will add final scores. Paper scorecard is the official results.

Coaches please inform players:

Players report 15 minutes before Tee Time.

Identify and mark golf balls.

If playing a provisional ball, announce and ball type

Play two balls if not sure of ruling and keep two scores.

No talking with spectators and/or parents.

14 club rule

Sportsmanship is a must!! No throwing of clubs, profanity etc.

Coaching rule:

Coach(es) are allowed to speak with players during the round.

If player is in bunker – player must leave bunker to speak with the coach. The coach may enter the bunker after the player leaves to rake. May speak with the player if the player is on green.x

Coaches are NOT permitted to make a ruling on any team including their own. A coach from an opposing team may NOT give advice to a player on another team without that coach being punished for a violation of coaching rules.

No caddying allowed or anyone pushing a cart for the player. Spectators are NOT permitted to converse with players.

The head coach and/or school designate must wear an identifying name tag on the course.

We will play the Red Tees Please read and/or discuss the course rule sheet to players.

Yardage Markers are on the cart paths – Blue 200 – White 150 – Red 100 to center of green.

Rules committee: Tony Williams, Tournament Manager, and other rules officials to be named later.

Marshals will be on the course.

Any ties will start on Hole 1
